WE ARE DEEPLY ROOTED

WORSHIP: This morning, we welcome Vincent, Holly, Violet, and Kaius Muñoz to our First Pres family.

BAPTISM: Today, we baptize Vince Muñoz by immersion. Each method of baptism emphasizes a different aspect of baptism's meaning. Sprinkling invokes an Old Testament image for remission of sins. Pouring invokes the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Immersion invokes death to an old life and being raised into new life with Christ. All three are present at all baptisms. Vince has requested to be immersed today as he begins a new life with Christ.
